Technisource Announces Graduation of Second Technical Recruiting Class

Class Offers Unique Opportunity for New Graduates

LITTLE ROCK, Ark. - (November 12, 2007) - Technisource, a national information technology and engineering services provider, has announced the graduation of 16 new recruiters from the company's second recruiter training class (R101).
